**CONDITIONS OF THE GROUND HANDLING LICENCE (“GHL”) FOR
ASIA DIGITAL ENGINEERING SERVICES SDN. BHD. (COMPANY NO: 1366782-X)**

1. General

- 1.1 The conditions in this document are in reference to Ground Handling Licence [Certificate No.: **GHL000137**].
- 1.2 The GHL is valid for a period of thirty-six (36) months effective from **1 June 2024** to **31 May 2027**.
- 1.3 Pursuant to Schedule 2 of the Malaysian Aviation Commission Act 2015 [Act 771], Asia Digital Engineering Services Sdn. Bhd. (“**the Licensee**”) is permitted to undertake and operate aircraft maintenance service only.
- 1.4 The Licensee is permitted to operate the ground handling service in paragraph 1.3 at the following aerodromes only:

No	Station
1	Kuala Lumpur International Airport (“ KUL ”)
2	Penang International Airport (“ PEN ”)
3	Kota Kinabalu International Airport (“ BKI ”)
4	Kuching International Airport (“ KCH ”)
5	Langkawi International Airport (“ LGK ”)
6	Senai International Airport (“ JHB ”)
7	Miri Airport (“ MYY ”)
8	Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport (“ SZB ”)

- 1.5 The Licensee shall hold a valid maintenance approval issued by the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia at all times during the duration of the GHL.
- 1.6 The Licensee shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, rules, instructions, directives or codes as imposed by the Malaysian Aviation Commission (“**Commission**”) and the relevant authorities in the conduct of its business as a holder of the GHL.

2. Management

- 2.1 The Licensee shall not effect a material change in its shareholders and shareholding which may affect the control of the Licensee, without the written approval of the Commission.



- 2.2 The Licensee shall be of good standing and repute.
- 2.3 The Licensee shall be under the control of a Malaysian person at all times. A person shall control the Licensee if –
- (a) such person has an interest of more than fifty percent (50%) of the shares in the Licensee; and
 - (b) if such person –
 - (i) has the power to elect, appoint, remove or prevent from election, appointment or removal, or cause to be elected, appointed, removed or prevented from being elected, appointed or removed, a majority of the directors of the Licensee; or
 - (ii) has the power to make or cause to be made decisions in respect of the business or administration of the Licensee, and to give effect to such decisions or cause them to be given effect to; or
 - (iii) is a person in accordance with whose directions, instructions or wishes the directors, chief executive officer or senior officers of the Licensee are accustomed or under obligation, whether formal or informal, to act on.

Notwithstanding the above, the Commission may deem a person to have control over the Licensee where the Commission is satisfied that there are reasonable ground or grounds for doing so.

For the avoidance of doubt, a "person" in this context includes a body of persons, corporate or unincorporated.

- 2.4 The Licensee shall maintain its principal place of business in Malaysia at all times. For the avoidance of doubt, "principal place of business" means the head office where the principal financial functions and operational control of the company are exercised.

3. Operations / Financial

- 3.1 The Licensee shall fulfil all relevant insurance requirements as determined by the Commission.



- 3.2 The Licensee shall display a copy of the GHL in a conspicuous place at its aerodrome office or at its principal place of business.
- 3.3 The Licensee shall upon request, furnish to any person information concerning the terms of the GHL.
- 3.4 The Licensee shall ensure that there are no outstanding payments due to the Commission.
- 3.5 The Licensee shall fulfil all financial requirements as determined by the Commission.
- 3.6 The Licensee shall ensure that there are no outstanding salaries, allowances or other relevant benefits due to any employee.
- 3.7 The Licensee shall submit to the Commission its financial, operational or any other reports as requested by the Commission.

4. Others

- 4.1 Pursuant to subsection 40(2) of Act 771, the Commission may, at any time in its discretion, add, cancel or vary any of the conditions attached to the licence.
- 4.2 The Commission may, by written notice to the Licensee and without compensation, revoke or suspend the GHL if any of these conditions has not been complied with pursuant to subsection 43(1) of Act 771.
- 4.3 A GHL holder who fails to comply with any of the conditions imposed by the Commission commits an offence and shall on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding RM500,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five (5) years or to both.

These conditions come into operation on 1 June 2024 and are hereby attached to the Ground Handling Licence [Certificate No.: **GHL000137**].
